NJ Lottery and Council on Compulsive Gambling of New Jersey Kick-Off Annual Gift Responsibly Awareness Campaign

"GIFT RESPONSIBLY. LOTTERY TICKETS AREN'T CHILD'S PLAY."

TRENTON (Nov. 30, 2021) – The New Jersey Lottery has teamed up with the Council on Compulsive Gambling of New Jersey, Inc. (CCGNJ) to launch the Lottery's 2021 holiday Gift Responsibly Awareness Campaign: *"Gift Responsibly. Lottery Tickets Aren't Child's Play."*
