TRENTON (Nov. 30, 2021) - The New Jersey Lottery has teamed up with the Council on Compulsive Gambling of New Jersey, Inc. (CCGNJ) to launch the Lottery's 2021 holiday Gift Responsibly Awareness Campaign: "Gift Responsibly. Lottery Tickets Aren't Child's Play."
